



SQL Database PIVOT User & Password Authentication Test

1. Open Microsoft SQL Server Management Studio
2. Follow the layout below to attempt to perform “SQL Server Authentication” with the new PIVOT SQL login you created.
3. Select “**Connect**” once you have input the correct information.
4. If your PIVOT SQL login credentials authenticate, then continue to [Step 3 “EA How to Find Database & Server IP Address”](#).
5. If your PIVOT SQL login credentials do not authenticate, then repeat Step 2. Some setting or configuration during the setup of your new SQL Database User ID and Password was performed incorrectly.
